Where?

Florence, Italy, the capital of Tuscany - also the location of the accommodations and facilities.

HOW LONG?

The program runs concurrently with the Academy of Art University onsite 7 week summer semester.

WHAT ABOUT CLASSES?

Classes will run Monday through Thursday during the 7 week course period, 8:30am to 3:00pm.

You can take one of the following 6 unit classes:

Fine Art: Printmaking & Book Arts Fine Art: Painting & Drawing Fine Art: Sculpture Photography

Or you can take the following 3 unit course:

Liberal Arts: Art & Architectural History

LAND COST PACKAGE

Includes:

Welcome Dinner and Orientation including Florence overview, health, safety and housing

- 24-hour emergency assistance
- Student housing in double occupancy rooms in shared student apartments with approximately 4-6 students per apartment
- Apartments are furnished and have fully equipped kitchens
- AAU Instructors
- Studio Facilities (including printmaking inks)
- On campus WiFi for students and faculty
- Gallery Group Show in gallery space at the SRISA facility
- Mandatory site visits to:
 - 1-day site visit to Pienza, transportation & guided tour

Land Cost: \$5,800.00 (approx.) + \$250.00 refundable (or \$500 for private housing) housing deposit

Refund Policy: ½ the land cost will be payable by student if they withdraw from the program after April 25th, 2018 The Student Fee is non-refundable 7 days prior to the start of your program.

GOAL: To broaden each student's artistic education by experiencing the art and culture of Italy during a 7 week study abroad program in Florence, Italy.

GUEST PARTICIPATION FEE \$350/ Or \$75 per field trip Guest participants have access to SRISA cultural program, welcome dinner, front desk assistance, Emergency assistance by SRISA and staff and access to any 1-day field trips organized by SRISA for AAU.

Guests will be charged accordingly should they participate in SRISA housing.

Additional 400 Euro (\$550 USD) for the Venice 4-day trip (Guests must pay for field trips if they wish to join the group) Please note: NO reimbursements will be given to students who do not attend field trips.

EXTRA HOUSING FEE

If you wish to have your own apartment or you wish to have a single occupancy bedroom in a shared apartment. Single room in a shared student apartment: Additional \$350 Student Housing Security Deposit: \$250 (refundable) Private Apartments are available for those students that wish to be housed independently or that have family members joining them. Additional approx. \$2,000 Those requesting a private apartment must pay a \$500 refundable housing

AC is available only for those requesting private apartments; however, AC is not included in the price.

Not included in Land Cost Package

- 6 Units tuition: BFA: \$5,010 (approx.) MFA: \$5,610 (approx.)
- Flights. (Student must arrange) \$1,200-\$2,000
- Housing deposits (\$250 or \$500 for private apartment)
- Taxi (\$30) from airports to SRISA, in Florence to be arranged by student.
- Health Insurance \$100 (if needed per VISA)
- Air Conditioning (extra fees will be applied)
 \$100 ONLY AVAILABLE FOR PRIVATE APARTMENTS (private apartment fee will apply)
- Meals/Additional side trips as desired, daily expenses:
- Class fee, art supplies & museum passes, approx. \$ 200-250
- (each department is dierent check with your department)
- · Optional housing upgrades:

\$350 for single occupancy room in shared apartment \$2,000 approximately. for private apartment.

VISAS

Course Descriptions

Summer Semester Study Abroad 2018



FINE ART: PAINTING AND DRAWING

This class uses the magnicent countryside of Tuscany and cityscape of Florence as the subject for painting landscapes on location. It will include vistas and panoramas of the distant countryside, foliage, elds, and farms in a variety of compositions as well as the unique historical structures in and around Florence Color value and atmosphere will be stressed through varied individual directions. FINE ART: PRINTMAKING AND BOOK ARTS

Students will develop a portfolio of prints and artist's books derived from sketches made on location in the magnicent countryside and hill top Tuscan towns of Italy. Students will learn and practice a variety of printmaking techniques including relief printing, dry point intaglio, monotype and a variety of book structures ideal for showcasing art. FINE ART: SCULPTURE

This course covers sculpting techniques of the human form and head. Introducing armature building, clay modeling for sculpture, observational anatomy and ecorche anatomy. It will focus on sketches for sculpture designs. It includes individual expression, and surface finishing and explores two types of clay water based, and oil based. LIBERAL ARTS: ART & ARCHITECTURAL HISTORY

The study abroad course introduces students to the primary works of art and architecture in Florence.
